



General Promotion Procedures

Date: 1/30/13

General Rules

1. All prize winners must be 18 years or older. Winners will be required to provide proof of age.
2. The type of promotion will dictate the way in which the winner(s) will be notified of their winner status.
3. By participating in Oklahoma Lottery promotions each player authorizes the Oklahoma Lottery to release prize winner information to various media sources and list winners' names and pictures on the Oklahoma Lottery website, www.lottery.ok.gov, and at authorized OLC retailers.
4. The Oklahoma Lottery reserves the right at its sole discretion to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if any prize cannot be awarded as described due to unavailability or for any other reason. Additional restrictions and conditions specific to any particular prize will be disclosed to winners upon prize notification.
5. Prizes pictured in point-of-sale materials and on the Lottery website are for illustrative purposes only.
6. Winners of cash and merchandise prizes valued over \$600 will be issued a W2-G tax form. Cash prizes over \$5,000 are subject to federal and state tax withholdings at the time of prize awarding. Additional local, state, federal or other taxes, expenses or surcharges associated with the prizes (if any) and not mentioned in these rules are the responsibility of the winner.
7. The Oklahoma Lottery and its agencies are not responsible for error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials or for technical, network, telephone equipment, electronic, computer, hardware or software malfunctions of any kind, or inaccurate transmission of or failure to receive entry, winner or other contest information by sponsors or entrants for any reason whatsoever. The Oklahoma Lottery is not responsible for entries that are late, misdirected or incomplete. All entries become the sole property of the Oklahoma Lottery and will not be returned. **CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY AN ENTRANT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATIONS OF THE PROMOTION IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE OKLAHOMA LOTTERY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THE PROMOTION IF IT BECOMES TECHNICALLY CORRUPTED.**
8. The Oklahoma Lottery reserves the right to refuse admission of an entry or group of entries if it is determined that the submission has occurred under a pretense that does not conform to the above listed rules.
9. A minimum number of entries may be specified in order to qualify for an awarding of any or all of the prizes as described in the promotional procedures.

10. The Oklahoma Lottery will not provide any assurance and/or verification of receipt of any entry submitted by any player or promotion participant.
11. The Oklahoma Lottery makes no express or implied warranties of any kind with respect to the safety, appearance or performance of any prize offered.
12. Once final transfer of a prize is complete, the winner has sole ownership of the prize and the use of the prize is at the owner's discretion.
13. Each person entering this promotion agrees by the act of participation to be bound by these promotional procedures of the Oklahoma Lottery.
14. Any photos and/or creative content posted as an entry submission becomes the sole property of the Oklahoma Lottery to be used at their discretion for promotional purposes without any compensation to the person submitting.
15. These promotional procedures may be modified at any time at the sole discretion of the Oklahoma Lottery.

Types of Promotions

Second Chance Promotions

Player may purchase a designated ticket and submit any non-winning ticket (does not include free tickets) as an entry into a second chance promotion to win a predetermined prize.

Buy X, Get Y Promotions

Player may make a designated purchase to receive an entry to win a predetermined prize.

Mobile Club Promotions

Text or reply the specified short code to 44622 for a chance to win a predetermined prize.

Facebook Promotions

Facebook fans will be asked to comment or post various messages or pictures on the Lottery's Facebook fan page for a chance to win a predetermined prize.

Entry Submission Methods

Acceptable entry methods for each promotion will be designated in the promotional procedures and on the Oklahoma Lottery website.

Oklahoma Lottery Website

To enter, players must submit all of their contact information and the required codes from the designated ticket on the promotional web page located at www.lottery.ok.gov. The age verification box must also be completed providing confirmation that the entry is being submitted by a person at least 18 years of age. Players must save their original ticket once it has been entered online and may be required to reproduce the ticket during the validation process. Failure to re-produce the required ticket can result in disqualification.

Postal Mail

An official entry consists of an eligible ticket with all contact information completed and mailed to the Oklahoma Lottery headquarters. A complete name, address, telephone number, email (optional) and signature must be provided on the entry. If applicable, the age verification box must also be completed providing confirmation that the entry is being submitted by a person at least 18 years of age. Entries must be submitted in an envelope. Multiple entries in an envelope will be accepted. The Oklahoma Lottery is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, damaged, incomplete, altered, illegible or postage-due mail. Valid entries must be received in the offices of the Oklahoma Lottery by end of day on the final day of the entry period to be included in the corresponding drawing.

Deposit at Oklahoma Lottery Headquarters

Players may enter the promotion by depositing their entries with the Claims Department at the Oklahoma Lottery Headquarters. Oklahoma Lottery employees cannot hand deliver entries given to them from any participating individual and any entry delivered in such manner will be disqualified.

Mobile Club

Players may enter the promotion texting or replying a specified short code to the number 44622.

Facebook

Players may enter the promotion by participating in the described promotion on the Oklahoma Lottery Facebook Fan page.

Promotional Considerations / Restrictions

1. Do not enter the promotion in more than one method for each ticket (e.g. mail and online entry submissions). Players found to be doing so can be disqualified from the current as well as subsequent promotions.
2. If you receive multiple entry tickets from one transaction that have the same transaction number, you will only be able to enter one of the tickets online and the remainder of the tickets will have to be entered through postal mail. Only one entry for each transaction number can be entered online per promotion.
3. Winners of Mobile Club promotions must be active members and be an Oklahoma resident in order to qualify to win the prize.
4. Winners of Facebook promotions must be an Oklahoma resident in order to qualify to win the prize.
5. Players may only win one prize per promotion, unless otherwise noted in the specific Promotion Procedures.
6. Some prizes have an expiration date and will be forfeited if not claimed in time.

Drawings

Drawing Officials

For prizes valued under \$100, only the Drawing Manager and one other Security or Accounting Official must be present during the drawing.

For prizes valued at \$100 or more, the Drawing Manager and both the Security and Accounting Officials must be present during the drawing.

Online Entry Only

The Prize Drawings will be held at the Oklahoma Lottery headquarters. Only the Drawing Manager, an Accounting Official and a Security Official will be present during the drawing. Drawing officials will access the entry database via various electronic tools (Oklahoma Lottery website, Oklahoma Lottery Mobile Club website, Oklahoma Lottery Facebook fan page). A computer-based random number generator will be used to execute the official drawing once the final range of entries is determined. Promotion specific procedures will define the number of winners and alternates to draw. Alternates will only be contacted if the winner fails to complete the validation process.

The Drawing Manager will record the drawn ticket and entrant's information for all entries. Winner will then be contacted by the Oklahoma Lottery for prize fulfillment purposes. If there are not enough valid entries within the total that are drawn, an equal amount will be re-drawn for prize validation.

Mail and Online Entries

The Prize Drawings will be held at the Oklahoma Lottery headquarters. Only the Drawing Manager, an Accounting Official and a Security Official will be present during the drawing.

Mailed-in entries will be counted and weighed in order to calculate the total (estimated) number of entries. The total number of mailed-in entries will be compared to the total number of online entries to determine the percentage of entries per category. The official promotional procedures will then dictate the total number of semifinalists to draw (includes both winners and alternates). That number will be multiplied by the percentage of each entry category to determine the number to draw per category. A blindfolded employee (monitored by the drawing officials) will draw the required number from the mailed-in entries. The range of tickets for the online drawings will be entered into the Random Number Generator to determine the winners.

Once the semifinalist entry order is determined, the range of winners (and alternates) will be put into the Random Number Generator to determine the final winners. The Drawing Official will record all the information from the winning entries. Winner will then be contacted by the Oklahoma Lottery for prize fulfillment purposes. If there are not enough valid entries within the total that are drawn, an equal amount will be re-drawn and subsequently verified for validity.
